Market Commentary

January saw global equity markets make positive ground following recent weak performance. All major equity indices made gains over the month, with the S&P 500, FTSE 100 and Nikkei 225 up 8.0%, 3.6% and 3.8% respectively. Despite this turnaround, the same underlying geopolitical issues still seemed to persist. However, this time, added to the mix, was the US Government shutdown. As the 29th March approaches, progress with regards to Brexit was lacking. There was temporary optimism as MPs voted in favour of replacing the backstop, the insurance policy designed to avoid a hard border in Ireland in the event of a no deal. However, the EU seems adamant that there would be no change to the deal already agreed. Despite this gridlock, the pound rose 3.0% against the euro. Amongst other currencies, the pound rose 2.9% against the US dollar. In the fixed income market, the yield on US, UK and Germany 10-year bonds decreased 5, 6 and 9 basis points respectively.


Key Contributors to Return

Las Vegas Sands' shares increased by 12.1% after the market continued to report strong Macau numbers and strong results from competitors. HCA Healthcare's shares increased by 12.0% after reporting strong quarterly results, which beat consensus estimates at both the revenue and profit level.

Key Detractors from Return

Paddy Power Betfair's shares declined by 2.1% after the Department of Justice reversed its interpretation on the federal law prohibiting the operation of certain types of betting businesses in the US. Crown Resort's shares only increased by 0.8% with more defensive names failing to participate in the market rally.

Performance Since Inception (14/04/2011)²







Investment Philosophy

Credo's investment philosophy is based on the following tenets:

- We believe wealth is created and preserved by following a patient and disciplined investment strategy that is focused on the long-term.
- We follow a value-based approach to investing.
- We strive to identify matters of strategic importance and focus on methodologies that have proven to be robust through a variety of market cycles, rather than fixating on short-term news-flow and forecasts.
- We aim to minimise turnover in our portfolios and apply our minds when considering transaction size in an attempt to limit transaction costs.
- We view risk as permanent losses of capital and not in terms of short-term volatility.

Portfolio incorporates all additions and removals, rebalancing all holdings to a 5% weighting in the process. 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
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








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
